We know over the road driving isn't easy especially sharing the road with others. Weather, traffic, delivery requests, and traffic delays require your immediate attention and awareness. Your ability to stay alert, follow procedures, and make the right call is greatly appreciated. As we move into the new year, we ask you to continue to protect yourself and others to ensure a safe delivery and return home. Although, this year was better than last regarding the number of claims and overall costs, there is much room for improvement and a reduction of claims. Here are a few things you can do to protect yourself and your cargo to ensure a safe delivery. Wear your seat belt, watch weather, plan your trip, get plenty of rest, pre & post trip inspections, report all damage to the loss prevention department, maintain a safe distance, and avoid congestion. Wind + Ice + Snow = NO GO!!



We have already had two loss of control/ Rollovers this season. It is important that you stay current with the weather, plan your trip accordingly & make smart driving choices during challenging weather conditions.

High Wind Safety Tips

- Check weather
- Be alert to vehicles around you
- Reduce your speed
- Correct your steering
- Use your flashers
- Increase following distance
- Stay centered in your lane
- Avoid stopping on the shoulder / safe parking area
- Watch for objects/ road debris
- Keep your hands firmly on the wheel



Winter Driving Safety Reminders

- Watch for weather conditions
- Shut down in hazardous road conditions
- Decrease your speed
- Allow more following distance
- Allow for more brake time on slick & snowy roads
- Avoid over-correcting your steering
- Anticipate lane changes, turns & curves in advance
- Take it slow when approaching intersections, off-ramps & bridges in case of black ice
- Keep windows, mirrors, headlights, taillights & brake lights clear of snow & ice
